

Did you know?

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The LCAP, the State mandated comprehensive Local Control Accountability Plan, has really had an impact on teaching and learning in the Lemon Grove School District.

Did you know?

Teachers will have additional collaboration time this year and students will have additional instruction in Art, Music and Physical Education.

Students will have an additional 15 minutes of instructional time each day (equal to an extra 1 ½ weeks of school).

All teachers will receive three days of professional development in their content area which will include support for English Learners.

Did you know?

Instructional coaches have been added to support English language development and math instruction, and Teachers on Special Assignment will continue to support specialization programs at school sites.

Playground supervision will increase this year.

After school clubs and sports activities will expand.

A plan to reach a 1:1 student to computer ratio will be implemented.

Did you know?

350 primary students have received individual tutoring in phonics over the past two years.

4 out of 5 grade levels met the local English Language Arts growth target on the 2015-16 CAASPP.

Did you know?

School site social worker and vice principal allocation has increased and all sites implemented restorative practices.

In 2015-16 attendance has increased, suspensions and chronic absenteeism have decreased and no students were expelled.

On the California Healthy Kids Survey student responses indicated improvement in each of the 14 social emotional indicators.

Did you know?

All classrooms in the district now have wireless access to the Internet.

By transitioning to chromebooks, student login time has decreased by ten minutes.

Over 50% of teachers have been trained in Google Apps for Education.

Every site has a technology assistant to help with technology issues.

Did you know?

Custodial services have increased for the past two years.

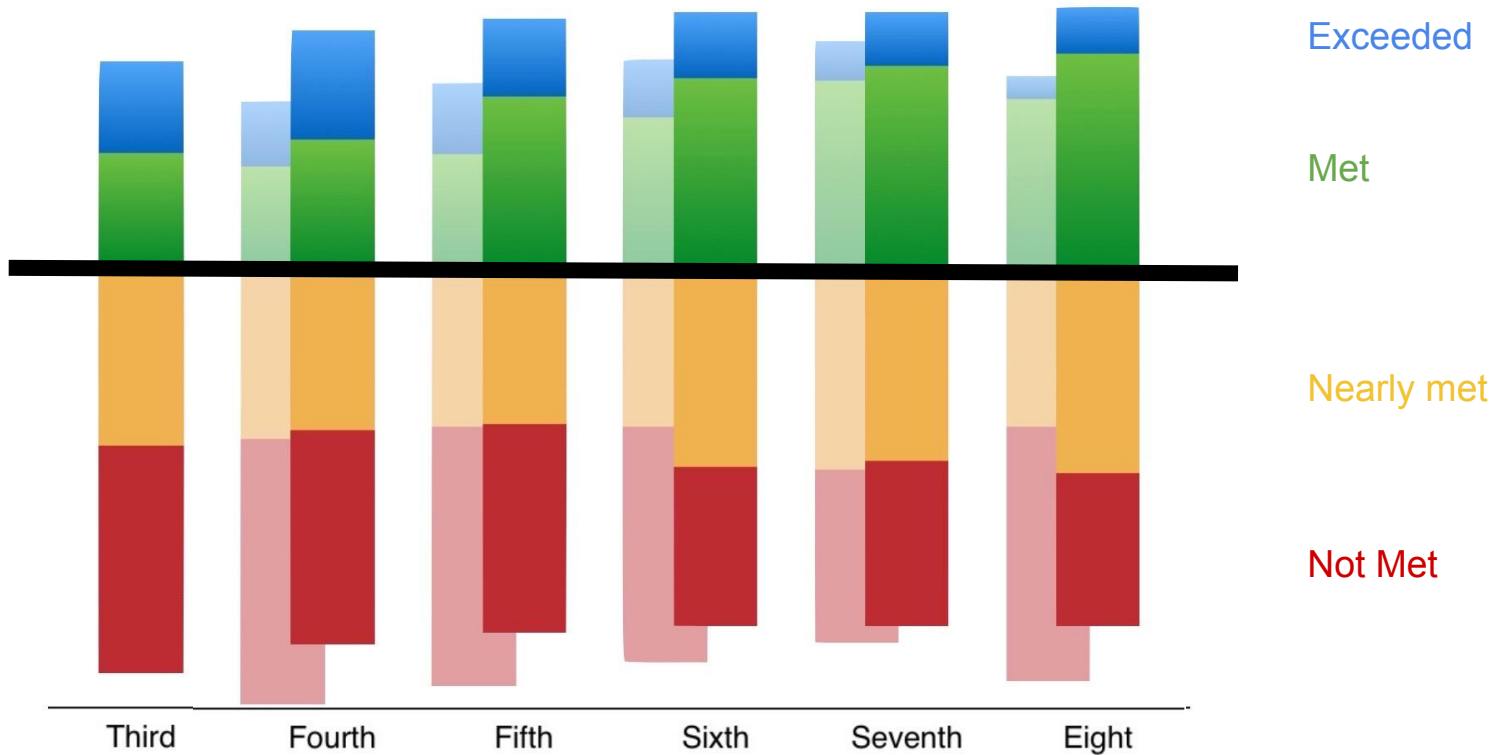
We have modernized the central kitchen, one athletic field and track, two playgrounds, and replaced windows, water systems and roofs.

Did you know?

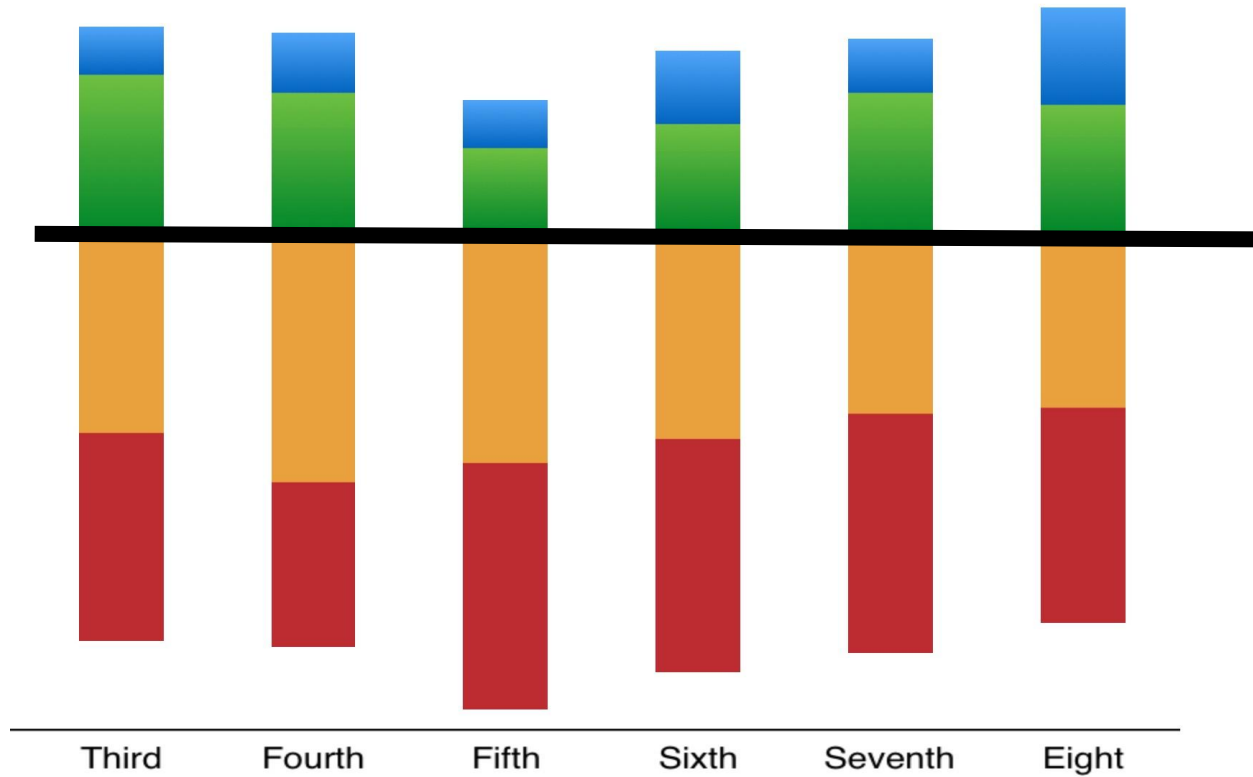
It was stakeholder input that guided all these great changes.

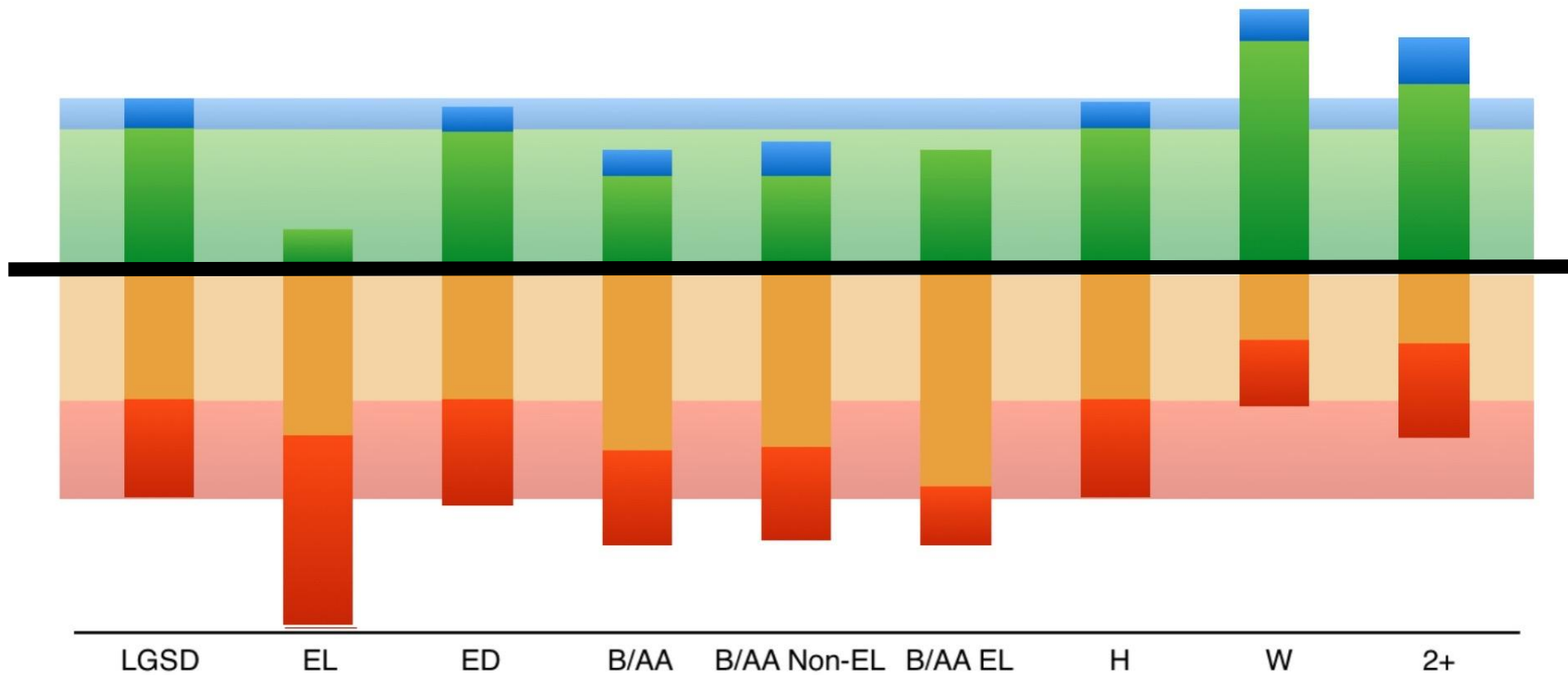

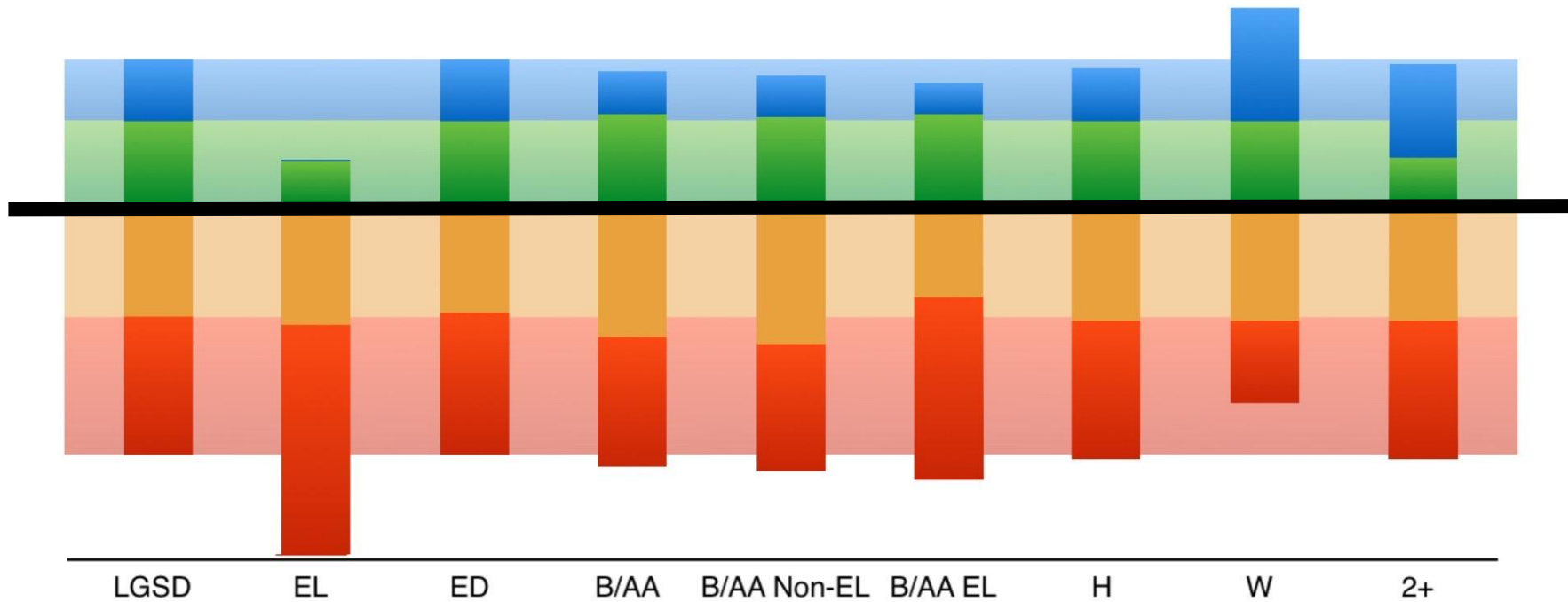
2015-2016 ELA Cohort
