What is Prop W? Proposition W was passed by voters in 2008. Approval of this \$28,000,000 school facilities bond provides Lemon Grove School District with the ability to continue to maintain and improve the learning environments for our students. The bond measure allows the following types of work:

- Construction science/technology labs
- Create a math, science and technology magnet middle school
- Repair and replace plumbing, heating and air conditioning systems
- Improve handicap access
- Renovate playgrounds and improve health and fitness facilities
- Upgrade existing facilities
- Improve energy efficiency
- Construct a joint use library/media center


What Projects Are Done?

Projects the district has completed so far are:

- Fencing to improve security at Golden Avenue, and Mount Vernon elementary schools, and Vista la Mesa Academy
- Locker room improvements at Palm Middle School and Vista la Mesa Academy
- Improved safety at Golden Avenue by adding a fire hydrant
- Investigated the status of plumbing at all sites to prepare for repair or replacement
- Playground equipment at Mt. Vernon, Monterey Heights & San Altos
- Solar energy production systems for Mt. Vernon, Palm & San Miguel
- Architectural design of the LGMS modernization and joint-use library addition
